to relieve the boredom: While doing your dishes play some old time favorites on the record player. Splurge and buy a pretty flower for the kitchen and utility room. For a change, get out one of your prettiest blouses to wear with your slacks—put on some make-up, too. Coloring eggs for Easter: First, for best results for hard-cooking eggs, put the cold eggs from the refrigerator in cold water to help keep them from cracking. Cover the eggs completely with at least one inch of water above the top of the eggs. Bring the water rapidly to a boil, then reduce the heat and simmer, just below the boiling point for at least 20 minutes. Plunge immediately in cold water to prevent yolk discoloration and for easier peeling. These eggs will be warm enough to take shell coloring. White shelled eggs are preferred for pastel colors and brown shelled eggs are nice for vivid colors.

Here's a timely spring fashion note, about 90 years old: High heeled boots must go. A lady looks infinitely taller and slimmer in a long dress than she does in a short costume. There is always a way of showing the feet, if desired, by making the front quite short, which gives, indeed, a youthful appearance to a train dress. The greatest attention must be paid to the feet with these short dresses and I may state here that high heels are absolutely forbidden by fashion. 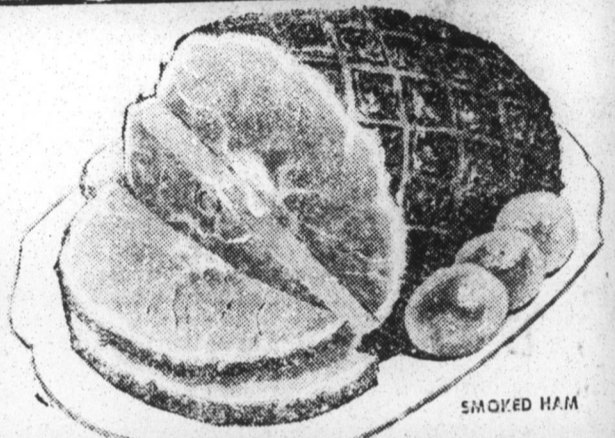

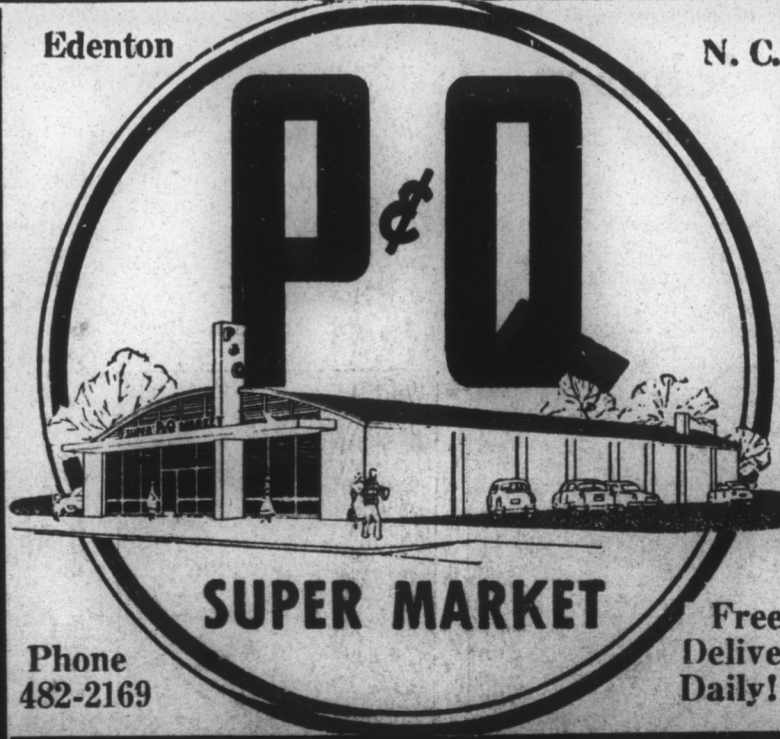
