Dr. Garland A. Hendricks, professor of Church Community Development and director of Field Work at the Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest, has accepted the invitation of the pulpit supply committee to preach at the Edenton Baptist Church on Sunday during the 11 o'clock morning service and during the 7:30 o'clock evening service. The pastor, Rev. R. N. Carroll, is on vacation.

Dr. Hendricks is an eastern North Carolinian by birth and, after graduating from Wake Forest College and the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Ky., has held pastorates in North Carolina and Kentucky. He holds the Th.D. degree from the Southern Baptist

Theological Seminary and the D.D. degree from Wake Forest College.

Having served as professor of Church Community Development at Gardner-Webb College in Boiling Springs from 1950 to 1953 he accepted the same affiliation with the Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest in 1953 and is presently serving in that capacity. He is active in the N. C. Baptist Convention and has written books on the church, with special emphasis on the rural church, and contributes to various periodicals.

The morning service will be broadcast over WCDJ and the supervised church nursery will provide care for children from cradle through age three for both services.
