A few cloves scattered in the corners of your kitchen shelves will discourage ants.

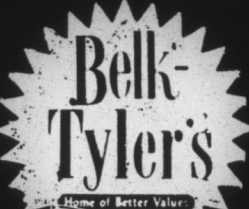
