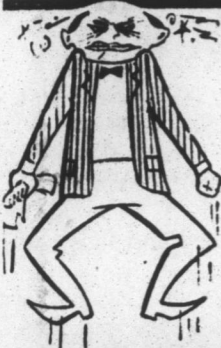
Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix thoroughly 1 cup Crisco, 1 1/2 cups sugar and 2 eggs. Sift together 2 1/2 cups flour, 2 tsp. cream of tartar, 1 tsp. soda and 1/2 tsp. salt and add to first mixture. Chill dough, roll into balls the size of walnuts, then roll in mixture of 2 tbsp. sugar and 2 tsp. cinnamon. Place 2 inches apart on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 8 to 10 minutes in oven until brown.

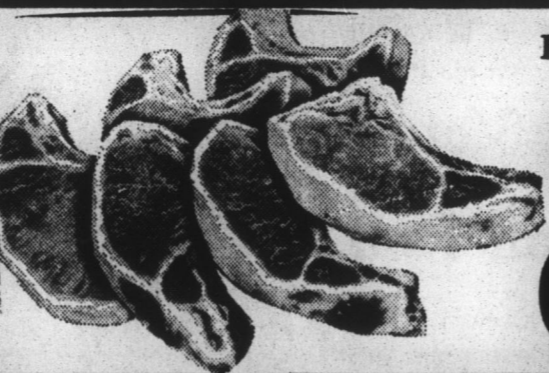
