Agents Attend State Meeting

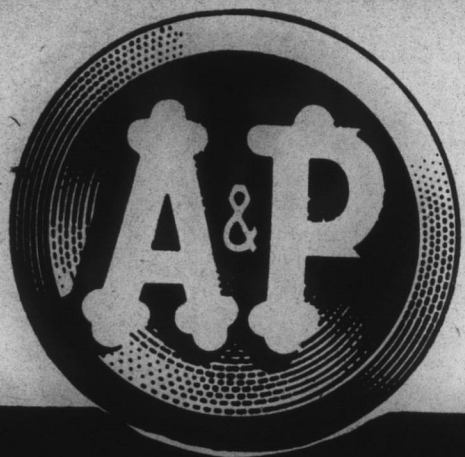
Home Economics Extension agents are participating in their annual meeting of the N. C. Association of Extension Home Economists.

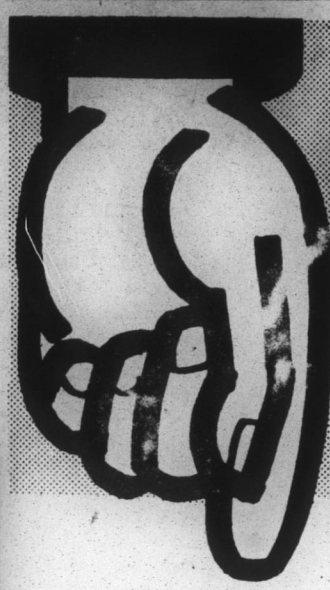
