Services Provided To 1,029

The Chowan County Department of Social Services provided financial assistance and/or service to 1,029 clients during February, according to a report filed by Ronald M. Huffman, director.

The report showed 67 service cases. There were 482 families certified for food stamps and 428 participated in the program during the month. The cases included 1,488 persons.

Other statistical information included: Aid to The Aged: 12 cases, \$1,561 grant; \$130.08 average.

Aid to Families With Dependant Children: 129 cases, \$18,901 grant.

Aid to The Disabled: Eight cases; \$1,276 grant; \$159.50 average.

Aid to The Blind: Six cases; \$714 grant; \$102.66 average.

General Assistance: One case, \$10.30 grant.

Ten cases hospitalized in the county at a cost of \$4,680.67; one hospitalized outside the county at a cost of \$92; nine out-patient

services, \$184.33; pharmacy services, \$3,939.92; and 23 dental services, \$833.50.

Also, 220 physician services, \$4,233.43; 10 nursing home cases, \$2,539.57; nine optical supplies, \$253.78; one mental hospital, \$899; four home health services, \$295; two physician family planning services, \$126.36; two health department family planning services, \$61.50; seven optometrists, \$169; 24 mental health clinics, \$408.22; 15 health department screening, \$225; and one health department clinic, \$8.
