

Armed Robbery Counts Reduced

Two armed robbery counts were reduced to assault with a deadly weapon in Chowan County District Court June 15 and the defendants were given suspended sentences.

Jesse Ray Holley and Virginia Holley were given identical sentences of two years, suspended upon payment of \$500 fine and costs. They were given until December 7 to make payment.

Holley was also tried before Judge Grafton Beaman of failure to appear pursuant to a release order. In this case he was given 60 days, suspended upon payment of \$200 fine and costs. He was given until September 14 to complete payment.

Does life exist outside this planet?

On July 4, 1976, when the Viking lander sets down on Mars to seek an answer to this question, a NOVA science special also explores the possibilities. "The Search for Life," Sunday, July 4, at 7 P.M. on Channel 2 includes the first films ever made of the Viking lander, taken over two years ago.

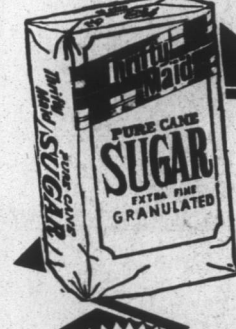
