Social Services Department Releases Report On Activities

The Chowan County Department of Social Services had 1,175 cases last month in which financial assistance and-or service was provided. This is contained in the monthly report released Monday by Ronald M. Huffman, director.

There were 482 cases certified for food stamps during the month. Of this number, 423 paid \$17,994 and received stamps valued at \$54,702. The cases include 1,518 persons receiving food stamps.


Carolina's most important industry," Hunt said, "and I believe we need a strong champion of the farmer in the governor's office.
