St. David's is one of the truly historical and unique churches of North Carolina. It remains in much the same condition as it was when completed. This year marks the 175th anniversary of the beginning of its construction.

In 1789 Rev. Charles first time to Tyrrell County. He remained for three years, moved to other adjacent counties and returned permanently in 1797. Charles Pettigrew was a teacher, farmer, businessman, clergyman, and the first person to be elected Episcopal Bishop of North Carolina.


