Under the program, called Third Party Notice, a person designated by a customer will be sent a copy of any past due notice that the customer receives. This notice will be sent in time for the third party to takesteps to handle the situation before any cutoff action is taken.

The Third Party can be anyone known by a customer--a relative, friend, clergyman, or social obligated to pay the guarantee that the bill is gram.

paid. The Third Party who may overlook their agrees only to receive a copy of the cutoff notice. It is then up to the individual to take appropriate action.

Kenneth W. Lane, manager of customer relations for Vepco, said, 'This is a good program

designed to prevent hardship, especially to our elderly or infirm customers. And, it is another step in Vepco's efforts to work individually with customers."

Lane said that Vepco is one of the few utilities in the nation to undertake such a program. He noted that all customers will receive an explanatory brochure with their monthly statement. 
