

Dinner Plans Completed

The N.C. Congressional Club has completed plans for a dinner honoring Sen. Jesse Helms in Edenton on January 20. The dinner will be held at the National Guard Armory at 8 P.M.

Sen. Helms, has compiled an admirable record in the U.S. Senate, practicing as well as preaching conservative principles. In the more than 2,600 roll call votes since he took office five years ago, Helms has maintained a 97 per cent voting record, and has returned to the U.S. Treasury over \$841,000 of the funds allocated for his official use.

Helms has sponsored or co-sponsored seventy pieces of legislation designed to aid the farmers of North Carolina. He believes that protection of the concept of the small American farmer is necessary, because "from the small farmer comes the character of this nation". Senator Helms serves on the Agriculture, Nutrition and Forestry Committee, the Armed Services Committee, and the Joint Committee on Congressional Operations.

Jesse Helms has been instrumental in efforts to retain U.S. jurisdiction of the Panama Canal, and advocates a national defense "second to none". He is a strong supporter of the free enterprise system. He proposes removal of controls that plague small businessmen, the requirement for a balanced budget, and the "restoration of fiscal sanity".

Sen. Helms was the first North Carolinian ever to receive the Senate's prestigious Golden Gavel Award, presented to those who preside over the Senate more than 100 hours. He was also awarded an unprecedented second Golden Gavel the following year.

The N.C. Congressional Club is a bipartisan organization of over 2,000 members state-wide. Sen. Helms serves as honorary

chairman of the club, which stands for principles of individual freedom, the preservation of the free enterprise system, and fiscally sound government.

A press conference will precede the dinner at 7:30 P.M. in the Armory.




