

Have you ever sat, or stood, on a street corner waiting for a bus, and noticed that each person passing has a characteristic walk? Some walk with confidence, some with a difficult trudge. Sometimes a walk can reveal a person's approach to life. It can relate to a person's way of living and acting. Walk could also refer to conduct and behavior.

We like to think that the Christian's walk, is a special kind of guided walk.
