Market Action Called Inactive

Southeastern Section — Trading of peanuts grown in the Southeast was inactive due to light offerings and due to the attendance of many industry members at the Aflatoxin Quality Control seminar in Chicago. Light planting continued in the Southeast but progress was interrupted by Rain. Prices paid per pound for shelled runner type peanuts, old crop (1978), sold on an FOB shipping point basis for April to May shipment were for Mediums 36½ cents; new crop U.S. Splits September to May shipment occasional 34.

Virginia-North Carolina Section — Trading of peanuts grown in Virginia and North Carolina was inactive due to light offerings for many grades and due to the attendance by many industry members at the Aflatoxin Quality Control seminar in Chicago. There were not enough sales of Unshelled Fancys to establish a market. Most shellers were filling previous commitments. Price paid per pound for Virginia Type peanuts sold on an FOB shipping point basis for prompt shipment (unless otherwise stated) were for Shelled Extra Large, mostly 44 cents; Medium 36 to 36½; Number Two with 70 per cent splits a few 33½. Sales of other grades were too few to quote.

Southwestern Section — Trading of peanuts grown in the Southwest was inactive due to light offerings and the attendance of many industry members at the Aflatoxin Quality Control seminar in Chicago. Valencia Supplies were very light and were mostly committed. Planting conditions continued to be excellent in South Texas. Prices paid per pound for Southwestern grown peanuts sold on an FOB shipping point basis for prompt shipment were for Shelled Spanish Type Jumbo 39½, Number One 38½, Unshelled Valencia Type handpicked few 38. Sales of Runners and other grades were too few to quote.
