

CAMA Officer Training Planned

Local Coastal Area Management Act (CAMA) permit officers will receive training for handling minor development permits in designated Areas of Environmental Concern. The training is being held on June 11 - 14, at the N. C. Marine Resources Center on Roanoke Island.

The training includes studies of Areas of Environmental Concern (AECs) standards for development, coastal management legislation and programs, the materials and procedures to be used to assist developers with projects in AECs, and other permitting responsibilities.

A field trip to estuarine and ocean hazard area sites is scheduled for June 13.

Permit officers attending the course include: Ralph Parish of Edenton and Chowan County.

The training course is sponsored by the N. C. Department of Natural Resources and Community Development's Office of Coastal Management. Permit officers must complete the course prior to the local governments issuing the CAMA minor development permit. A similar course will be held for CAMA permit officers in the State's southern coastal area on June 18 - 21.
