

Marathon Run Is Slated

WASHINGTON — The Third Annual Washington-Belhaven 26-mile Run-Walk-Run-Bicycle Marathon will be held July 4, kicking off the annual Belhaven 4th of July Festival and raising funds for World Vision International for their worldwide outreach programs.

The marathon will begin from the parking lot of the Y-Grocery located on River Road, five miles each of Washington, and proceed down Highway 308 from the "Y" to the intersection of Highway 264. Thence, participants will travel eastward along 264 through Yeatsville and Pantego, straight into downtown Belhaven, Main Street.

Each participant will receive certificates of appreciation, trophies, or medallions, depending upon order of finish. Four categories are scheduled for competition: 1) Run; 2) Walk-Run (Scout's Pace); 3) Bicycle; and 4) Special

Mode of Travel (i.e., speed-walk, unicycle, horseback, wheelchair, etc.).

Winners will be recognized in four divisions: Women; Men; Children (12 and under); and Seniors (35 and over). Awards will be presented at 3 P.M. at the Finish-line in downtown Belhaven.

The Marathon course is measured at 6.2, 10, 15, and 20 miles, enabling those who so desire to run a specific portion of the race and walk to the finish. Camping will be permitted by permission. Please contact W. Joe Davis, Box 5051, Raleigh, N.C. 27650.

The race will begin at 4:30 A.M. to enable "walkers" ample time to complete the distance. However, starting times will be staggered from 4:30 A.M. to 7 A.M. depending upon participant arrivals. Entries will be signed in, and clocked-out in groups. Finishers will be clocked-in at the Finisher's Table, downtown Belhaven.
