The woodtreating facility is primarily treating Landscape Timbers (trademark) manufactured from veneer log cores generated by company plywood plants at Plymouth and Jacksonville. The facility also treats dimension lumber and timbers manufactured at Weyerhaeuser sawmills at Plymouth and Lewiston.

The new plant treats about 32,000 Landscape Timbers or 340,000 board feet of lumber per shift each week. Plywood can also be treated to fill special orders.

The woodtreating is accomplished using chromated copper arsenate in a totally enclosed system, and the product is often is referred to as "pressure-" treated" wood.

The treated wood products are being sold through major national retail outlets such as Sears.
