Annual Herring Run Set

Saturday, May 3, has been set as the date of the Second Annual Herring Run. Races of one mile, three miles, and 10,000 meters (6.2 miles) will begin promptly at 10:30 A.M. from the cannons at the foot of the old Courthouse Green on Water Street. Race registration forms may be obtained by calling Jay Woglom, 482-

4120, or Hobie Truesdell, 482-8604, or by using the form appearing in this newspaper, at the banks in Edenton, or by signing up on the day of the race.

The race is being sponsored this year by Bank of North Carolina, Peoples Bank, Tarheel Bank, and Chowan Hospital, with refreshments being provided by Coca Cola Bottlers of Elizabeth City. Awards will be presented to each race winner. Tee shirts will be furnished to the first 200 entrants. All proceeds from the run are to go to the Heart Association.

Organizers anticipate that nearly all of last year's winning times will be bettered. The record for the 1 mile was won last year by Scott Dixon of Edenton in 7:23. Last year's 3 mile race was captured by Roland Stallings of Edenton in a time of 18:13. The 1979 10,000 meter trophy went to Joe Ambrozewicz of Elizabeth City who ran the distance in 36:13.

The race committee stresses that the event is designed for participation and open to everyone, with no age limitations.

Overpayments Are Recovered

RALEIGH — The state Employment Security Commission reported Tuesday that its anti-fraud unit recovered \$113,677 in unemployment insurance overpayments during March.

The unit also investigated 210 persons during the month and found that 161 of them had been overpaid a total of \$48,024. Thirty-five of those cases, involving a total of \$19,264, were classified as fraud. Non-fraud overpayments discovered in March totaled \$28,760.

Of the overpayments recovered by the unit during the month, \$90,548 was obtained by withholding payments to eligible unemployment insurance claimants, while \$23,129 was recovered through refunds to the commission from recipients of overpayments.

All 25 persons tried for fraud in the state's courts during March were convicted, the commission reported.
