levels. Shelia Cherry was a finalist in state competitions and went to the national competitions held in California last year.

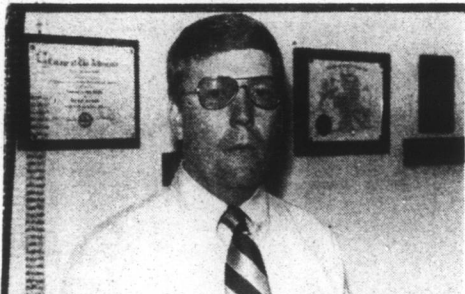
White Retires from Navy Duty


