The new lifetime licenses offered by the N. C. Wildlife Resources Commission are proving quite popular.

According to Jerry Wright of Currituck, Wildlife Commissioner for District one, "These lifetime licenses will not only save sportsmen money over the long run, but will also help wildlife for future generations. All of the revenues from the sale of lifetime licenses are placed in the Wildlife Endowment Fund, and the interest from this fund will be spent on wildlife conservations."

Lifetime licenses range in

price from \$100 to \$300, and a lifetime subscription to Wildlife In North Carolina magazine is available for \$100. Tax-deductible contributions may also be made to the Wildlife Endowment Fund.
