

Being only human, I could not accept the continued interference in area the department the operation of my operated with utmost indepartment by the Mayor of tegrity and honesty. I feel Edenton. This interference grew most intense after the departure of our City Manager of many years, Bill Gardner.

The Mayor began not only using his office to try to influence my administrative decisions within the Parks & **Recreation Department**, but even began dictating which umpires I could hire and fire. I was also pressured about changing a recreation ordinance concerning facility rental which the mayor himself watched. passed only months earlier at his own council meeting. Reluctantly, I then made Vitavax.

the decision to submit my resignation with the Town of Edenton, as I could no longer effectively operate my department under the prevailing restrictive conditions. But as though worship, at 11 o'clock to my years of service to the secure funds from the community meant nothing
