Fred Nielsen, IRS district director in North Carolina, said, "We don't intend to discourage legitimate contributions to churches, but designating funds by an individual to a child's scholarship or tuition is what we consider an abusive tax shelter and is clearly not allowable."

The director said that personal items and cannot be claimed on the tax return as a church contribution. Contrbutions to a church are allowable only if given to the church to be used for the religious program of that church, he added.


