Always a crowd pleaser, Chapdelaine has done much to dispel the myth that a classical guitar concert must be a stuffy event. The

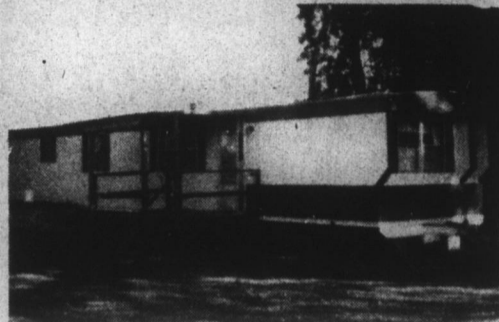

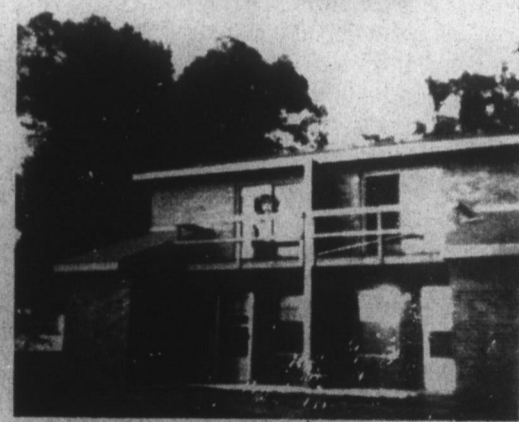
