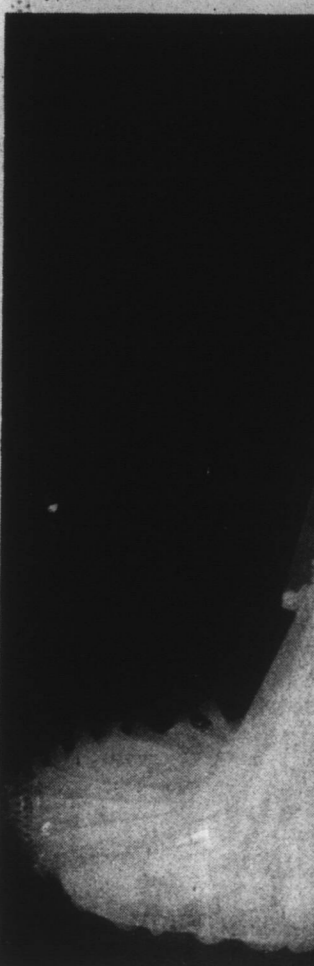


## Hollowell - Ward United In Marriage
