Iredell Portraits, Silver Urn To Remain In Edenton

Portraits of James and Hannah Iredell have come home to Edenton, as well as a silver urn belonging to Governor James Iredell Jr., to be displayed at the Iredell House.

The valuable acquisitions were presented at a coffee hour on November 18 at the historic house on East Church Street.

The original oil portraits were donated by descendant Iredell Jones IV of San Antonio, Texas, who with his wife, daughters, Lacey and Erinn; and his mother Mrs. Iredell Jones III of Wedgefield, South Carolina participated in the ceremony.

Mrs. Wood Privott, chairman of the Descend-

ants Committee, accepted the portraits of James Iredell, an Associate Justice of the U. S. Supreme Court, and his wife, Hannah, for the James Iredell Association.

In a recent letter to Mrs. Privott, the donor wrote that he wanted the portraits in the Iredell House as a final resting place, where they should be. The Iredell Jones family has had the portraits in their possession for over 50 years.

John Smith, association president, stated they were most fortunate to receive the portraits as they were sought for the Hall of Justice in Washington, D.C. and the courthouse in Iredell County.

The painter of the two portraits is not known, but it could have been Gilbert Stewart or Peele. Research will be done by state historical experts to determine the artist.

Iredell was appointed by George Washington to the first U. S. Supreme Court in 1790 and served until his death in 1799. He married Hannah Johnston of Hayes Plantation. They lived and raised their children in the house, which is now a state historic site.

Also presented at the ceremony, was a silver Sheffield tea urn that belonged to Governor Iredell. The donors of the gift were descendants Mr. and Mrs. James Iredell and

Miss Martha Iredell, all of Norfolk, Va.

The tea urn was accepted by Mrs. George Hoskins, chairman of the Furnishings Committee, and Richard W. Sawyer, Jr., administrator of the Historic Sites Section of the N. C. Department of Cultural Resources in Raleigh.

Among the 40 people attending was George Byrum, representing the Edenton Historic Commission, who expressed appreciation for the significant gifts. Also present were Lloyd Green, long active in the preservation of the house, and Mike Smith, furnishing specialist with the State Historic Sites Section.

Importance Of Your Medical History

Your general medical history has a lot to do with the type of treatment you will receive at your dentist. For example, if you are taking a drug affecting blood clotting, the dentist should be informed so as to be aware of potential hemorrhaging problems should he have to extract a tooth.

A patient with high blood pressure should certainly inform the dentist. Certain anesthetics and medications should be used in preference to others.

If you have some form of heart condition, the dentist may change his method of working with you. The patient with a cardiac pacemaker

should certainly inform his dentist. The dentist might have planned to do electrosurgery, a technique that utilizes high-frequency current to remove gum tissue. If the pacemaker doesn't have proper shields or safeguards, the high frequency current could cause it to stop or become erratic. The dentist can use other means of treatment.

If you are pregnant, diabetic, allergic to certain medication, your dentist must know these things - it's for YOUR benefit.
