PENALTY ON DELINQUENT UTILITY BILLS

Effective immediately all Town of Edenton utility customers who do not pay their utility bills by the 20th of the month on which they are billed shall be charged a 10 per cent penalty as specified on the reverse side of the utility bill.

Should a utility customer mail a check for a delinquent utility bill without including payment of the 10 per cent penalty, the penalty shall be included on the following month's utility billing.

All Town of Edenton utility customers are urged to pay their utility bills prior to the 20th of each month in order to avoid assessment of a 10 per cent penalty on their accounts.
