New Chairman Named By Hunt

RALEIGH - Glenn R. Jernigan, a Democrat and native of Fayetteville, was named on December 11, by Gov. James B. Hunt, Jr., to the position of chairman, Employment Security Commisssion (ESC) of North Carolina. Jernigan will assume leadership of the agency on January 1.
At the time of his ap-

pointment, Jernigan was representing the 10th Senatorial District (Cumberland County). Jernigan was duly elected to the N. C. Senate in 1975. He was appointed in 1979 to fill the unexpired term of Sen. John T. Henley. Senate committee appointments have included the Chairmanship of Election Laws and Manufacturing Labor and Commerce Committees as well as a seat on ten other committees.

Jernigan was born in LaGrange, April 10, 1939, to Claude J., Sr., and Lydia E. (Jones) Jernigan. His parents are now deceased. He was graduated Fayetteville High School, Campbell College and East Carolina University. Jernigan served in the U.S. Army Reserves.

Jernigan has been affiliated with seven professional or service organizations as well as the Board of Trustees for East Carolina University. He has received recognition and honors in five categories of community service and he has been listed in "Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities.'

Glenn Reginald Jernigan married Jane Clark Jernigan August 3, 1963. Their children, Lisa and Glenn, Jr., reside with them currently in Fayetteville. As a member of the Highland Presbyterian Church, Jernigan also serves as Deacon and Session Member, teaches Sunday School and functions in the Church Stewardship Committee.

Chairman Jernigan will head the seven-member Employment Security Commission, a budget of \$58-million and approximately 2,500 employees who are located in a network of offices serving all 100 counties in the state.
