**Report Is Issued**

**On Traffic Growth**

RALEIGH — A report on recent major air traffic growth and various construction programs at Douglas Municipal Airport in Charlotte was presented during the North Carolina Aeronautics Council meeting in Raleigh January 15.

Jerry Orr, Assistant Airport Manager of Douglas Municipal Airport, will discuss the airport's growth and development programs, which include a new terminal building, currently under construction. The terminal is expected to be in operation May 2.

The council will also consider state airport aid requests from four airports totaling \$298,444. Included in the requests are: \$168,310 for the Smith Reynolds Airport in Winston-Salem; \$62,500 for the Rutherford County Airport near Rutherfordton; \$38,134 for the Anson County Airport near Wadesboro; and \$29,500 for the Simmons-Nott Airport in New Bern.

The council will be briefed on the state's new heliport program. As part of the briefing, an industry film entitled "Helicopters, Heliports and You," will be shown to the council.

"We believe that the establishment of heliports in the state's communities will be a major consideration of business and industry when reviewing potential plant locations in the state," said Rep. Dan Lilley of Kinston, chairman of the council.






