Due to the Communist take-over of Hungary, Dr. Udvarnoki came to the United States in 1947 and became a citizen in 1953. He has been pastor at Gatesville Baptist Church and the author of books and articles for such publications as Christianity Examiner, Canadian Baptist, Biblical Recorder and The Baptist Program. He is a lecturer on European

"Evangelism Hirnok' (Gospel Messenger) an American Hungarian bi-monthly Baptist magazine. Mrs. Udvarnoki is a native

of Granville County, N.C. She was educated at Chowan College, Murfreesboro, N.C. and WMU Training School, Louisville, Kentucky. In 1935, she was appointed by the Foreign Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention to work in Hungary. She was transferred to Today, Watchman Bucarest, Romania in 1936 and returned to Budapest, Hungary in 1938. Invasion by communism forced her to leave Hungary in 1942. Following this, she served Germany, and Southern Affairs and Christianity as Dean of Women and Baptist Theological Behind the Iron Curtain. Professor of Missionary Affairs and Christianity as Dean of Women and

Baptist Theological Seminary. A sud emergency arose which caused the Foreign Mission Board to send her to Iwo, Nigeria to serve as Professor of English in a boys college for two years. In 1947 she married Dr. Bela Udvarnoki. She taught from 1953-1966. She is active in local community and church affairs and visiting the

# Maritime Conference Is Planned

How have the sea and the coast affected North Carolina through the years? What does the future hold for the area?

The life of North Carolina coastal cultures and other aspects of North Carolina's maritime heritage will be explored during the second N. C. Maritime Heritage Conference March 5.
