zeroing out of peanut allotments of non-producers who leased out their acreage were successful. The loss of peanut allotments by the producers was delayed one year, which means the 1982 crop season will not be affected.

Producer interpretation from information previously supplied by the ASCS had led producers to actions concerning their allotment (i.e., leasing of allotments in 1982), feeling they would not jeopardize their quotas. Implementation of the peanut program as outlined in the 1981 Farm Bill would have unfairly penalized growers or caused them to

lose their quotas. I realize this is a shortterm solution, but it buys the

agricultural sector time to work toward an equitable solution to this problem.


