Ware To Be Speaker At Immanuel Baptist

The Reverend Bob Ware of Orlando, Florida, will be the guest speaker for a series of meetings at the Immanuel Baptist Church, March 15 through 19 at 7:30 P.M. nightly.

Dr. Ware is the pastor and founder of the Tabernacle Baptist Church of Orlando. Daily he conducts a radio broadcast in the Central Florida area.

Dr. Ware served nine years in the United States Navy, during which time he was converted and called into the ministry. Upon discharge, he became the pastor of the Immanuel Baptist Church of Edenton, North Carolina.

Dr. Ware is considered to be an authority in church growth and development. He is in demand for conferences and special meetings, in addition to revivals and luncheons.

Currently, Dr. Ware holds three Doctorate Degrees: from Freedom University of Orlando, Florida, Fundamental Bible Seminary of Tullahoma, Tennessee, and Sacramento Baptist College of Sacramento, California; a Masters Degree from Freedom University; and a Bachelor's Degree from Berea School of Theology.

Tabernacle Baptist Church has a variety of ministries. The church has a deaf ministry with interpreters for every service.

The church owns and operates fourteen buses covering a two-county area, providing free transportation for hundreds each Sunday. The youth and teens have special activities weekly. A senior citizens group, the "Super Sixties", is the largest group of its kind in the Central Florida area, and has a weekly meeting offering free transportation and a special program with a meal, offered at no cost or dues. Tabernacle Baptist also has the Berea Baptist Mission Board supporting missionaries throughout the world Heritage Preparatory Schools and Heritage College were founded to provide a quality education in a Christian atmosphere.

tillage tools will be carried by IH dealers to match the capabilities of these new models and add to their versatility.

Peanut Crop Not Affected

Earlier this year, I wrote Secretary of Agriculture John Block requesting that he delay implementation of certain provisions of the peanut program as outlined in the 1981 Farm Bill. I also

began working with Congressman Charlie Rose toward a solution to the problem.

Today, I was informed by Congressman Rose that our joint efforts to prevent zeroing out of peanut allotments of non-producers who leased out their acreage were successful. The loss of peanut allotments by the producers was delayed one year, which means the 1982 crop season will not be affected.

Producer interpretation from information previously supplied by the ASCS had led producers to actions concerning their allotment (i.e., leasing of allotments in 1982), feeling they would not jeopardize their quotas. Implementation of the peanut program as outlined in the 1981 Farm Bill would have unfairly penalized growers or caused them to lose their quotas.

I realize this is a short-term solution, but it buys the agricultural sector time to work toward an equitable solution to this problem.
