COA- Electronic Data Processing

Provided it receives approval from the State Board of Community Colleges, a new, two-year curriculum program, Electronic Data Processing, will be initiated at College of The Albemarle this fall.

The associate in applied science degree program received the sanction of the COA board of trustees during its regular meeting at the college last week (March 10), following a description by Norman L. Norfleet, dean of instruction.

Norfleet explained that, basically, the curriculum will be a modified business administration program with concentration on micro-computers. It is comprised of 10 EDP courses integrated with other required business subjects including accounting, mathematics, English, and management.

He told the trustees the decision to develop EDP as a degree program was based upon two factors. First, he said, surveys among area high school students indicated a strong preference for a curriculum of this type.

The second reason the dean cited is the advent of micro-computers. He explained the relative low cost of the compact systems, with their high level of flexibility, has placed them within the reach of many small businesses. As more businesses turn to computerization, the demand for programmers is expected to increase dramatically.

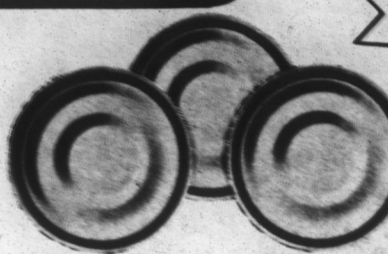
