The famous voyages of discovery, another gift from the Renaissance, will be the subject of discussion during the next-to-last session "The Human Dimension" humanities series at 7:30 P.M. on March 30, at College of The Albemarle

Well-known local scholar, Dr. Louis V. Nadeau, professor of philosophy at Elizabeth City University, will present the lecture. His discussion will describe the excitement of the times as man experienced a physical expansion of his terrestrial norizons through the discovery of new lands.

More exciting were the discoveries of Copernicus, Galileo, and Kepler, according to Nadeau. His discourse will reveal many of the emotions of these Renaissance astronomers, who were the first to glimpse worlds beyond man's reach.


