DeVine, Lane Are Re-Elected

Drs. Leibert E. Devine and Robert Earl Lane have been re-elected to the North Carolina Academy of Family Physicians. In order to become eligible for the honor, the doctors were required to complete 150 hours of continuing medical education (CME) during the past three years. They joined more than 200 of the state's nearly 1,000 practicing family physicians in achieving the educational goal. The primary thrust of the NCAFP, a constituent chapter of the American Academy of Family Physicians, is continuing medical education. In ad-

dition to the 150 hours required for re-election to the NCAFP, members must accumulate 300 hours for ABFP Board re-certification. Family practice is the only medical specialty to require re-certification every six years. Family practice became a medical specialty February 8, 1969 with the inception of its residency training program. During the initial period of the specialty, (then) general practitioners were allowed to take a certification examination and become family physicians. Now, however, all must complete a three-year family practice residency training program. Family practice is the nation's largest medical specialty comprising over 50,000 family physicians. (A service of the North Carolina Academy of Family Physicians).
