Hog Farmer Garbage Feeding Permit Revoked

RALEIGH - A Morrisville hog farmer has had his garbage feeding permit revoked by the N. C. Department of Agriculture for feeding raw garbage to swine.

In notifying Louis Barbee of Route 2, Morrisville of the revocation, state Agriculture Commissioner Jim Graham informed him that sufficient evidence existed to revoke the permit.

Following an investigation by NCDA animal health officials, it was determined Barbee was feeding uncooked garbage from sources other than his own residence.

Feeding garbage to swine,

from sources other than one's residence, that has not been cooked for 30 minutes at 212 degrees is forbidden under North Carolina law. Uncooked garbage may contain disease - causing organisms, particularly the hog cholera virus sometimes

found in raw pork scraps. Several years ago hog cholera reached epidemic proportions in the state and nation causing heavy economic losses. North Carolina and the U.S. are now hog cholera - free but the possibility still exists
