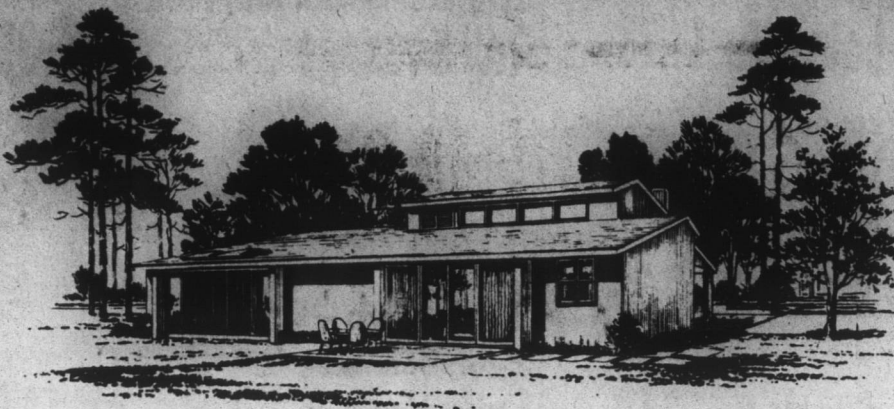
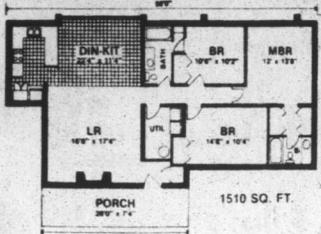


# Plans For New Solar Home

## The Coast Guard's Sailing Ship "Eagle" To Visit

The Coast Guard's sailing ship "Eagle" will visit Washington, D.C.; Norfolk, Va.; Philadelphia; New York and Portland, Ma. during the coming summer months. The square-rigged, three-masted barque, used to train cadets at the Coast

Guard Academy, will dock in these cities as part of its summer cruise schedule. The 295-foot Eagle will begin its summer visits with a three-day stop in Washington, D.C. May 25-28, following 10-day underway training in the Atlantic. This

visit will be followed by visits to Norfolk, June 11-14, Philadelphia, June 17-21, New York, July 2-6, and Portland, July 16-19. Eagle will leave Washington, and following several days at sea, put in to Norfolk, for a three-day stay starting June 11. The Eagle's visit will be a highlight of the Norfolk Harbor Fest.

GREENSBORO, - Plans for a new version of the Carolina Masonry Solar Home have been announced by the Carolinas Concrete Masonry Association.

The original plans No. 101 for this all-concrete masonry passive solar home were announced in 1981. The plans have been well received. A number of them have been built in the Carolinas.

The new floor plan and roofline allows the south-facing glass and trombe wall to be on the rear elevation of the house. This greatly increases the options a builder or developer has in selecting lots in a subdivision. The original plan 101 has south-facing glass and trombe wall in the front elevation.

The plans claim an energy conservation level ranging from 90 per cent in the coastal thermal zone to 57 per cent in the coldest mountain zones.

The solar design features an innovation element that puts the insulation on the exterior of the house. It is rigid insulation that is mechanically fastened to the concrete blocks.

The insulation is covered and protected with a special surface bonding cement that results in a finished exterior appearance and is available in several colors. The builder also has the option of masonry veneer or wood exterior.

According to a spokesman, placing the insulation outside of the concrete blocks takes advantage of the thermal storage capacity and the mass factor of the concrete masonry.

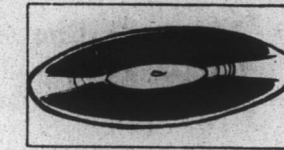
The plans were specially created for the association by Innovative Design of Raleigh.

The new plan 102 has a base plan featuring three bedrooms in 1,510 square feet of space. The original plan 101 also has three bedrooms and offers 1,287 square feet. In addition a three-bedroom solar floor plan of 994 square feet has been created to meet the needs of the Farmer's Home Administration.

Plans for each of the three

houses are \$35. If additional plans of this house are desired with the order, they are \$10 each. Add \$3.50 for handling and postage. The address is Carolinas Concrete Masonry Association, 2306 W. Meadowview Rd., Greensboro, N. C. 27407. The telephone number is 919-852-2074.

Although the architectural drawings for each of the house plans will be sold for \$35 a set plus handling and postage, the CCMA office offers free information on the use of concrete masonry in passive solar design.

## The Washington Report

The United States House of Representatives continues to have a rather light legislative schedule as far as legislation is concerned, and during the entire week, only seven bills were considered on the Suspension Calendar, none of which will change the course of history. They ran the gamut of transferring some property to Hobucken, New Jersey from the federal government to tax exemption for the District of Columbia sales tax for the Capitol Historical Society.

Although little or nothing is being done on the House Floor, the Committees continue to work diligently. The Merchant Marine and Fisheries Committee during the week conducted hearings on a bill supposedly designed to control waste dumping into the oceans. At the same time another Subcommittee is

considering the Maritime Regulatory bill which will radically change some of the rules and regulations under which the merchant marine fleet as well as shippers and others are controlled. Last Thursday Secretary of Transportation, Drew Lewis, appeared before our Subcommittee and it seems for the first time in many years that the Administration and our Committee have almost reached a compromise which probably insures the passage of the bill later on. I have stated many times my concern over the failing strength of our merchant marine fleet. The legislation being discussed is designed to remove some of the restrictions now imposed by the Department of Justice, offer some tax relief and liberalize some of the rules and regulations which have been on the statute books for 30 or 40 years. Efforts were made two years ago to pass the massive Omnibus Merchant Marine bill, but due to the fact that it contained so many radical changes, it broke down of its
