64; assets of \$50,000 for those persons 65 and older; and assets of \$65,000 for a handicapped person who requires a constant attendant.

The income limits may be increased by \$500 per family member after the fourth. Single - person households without dependents may also qualify; the income limit is \$17,625 in urban counties and \$15,375 in rural counties. Rural counties are designated as those who do not contain a city with a population of at least 20,000.

The N.C. Housing Finance Agency was created by the N.C. Legislature to work with private lending institutions in providing mortgage financing to low - and moderate - income families and individuals. It is self - supporting, and obtains funds to make the below market interest rate mortgage loans by selling tax - exempt revenue bonds on Wall Street. The money still remaining for the single - family loans was generated by a \$30 million revenue bond sale in November.
