It would cancel medical evaluations as well as dental care in nursing homes. Requirements for the nutrition would also be abolished.

In addition, standards mandating nursing homes to accommodate the handicapped and disabled would be cancelled.

The Governor's Advisory Council on Aging viewed all of these revisions with alarm. It is a function of the Council to make recommendations to the Secretary of Human Resources designed to improve human services to the elderly in North Carolina.
