

CRC To Hear Appeals And Proposals

The Coastal Resources Commission will invite comments from the public on proposals for new public beach access rules, a permit fee increase and consolidated hearing procedures at its meeting May 20 - 21 in Jacksonville at the Holiday Inn.

Committees of the CRS will review public comments in deciding what

proposals to present to the full commission. The public hearings on these issues will begin at 10 A.M., May 20.

The issues of floating houses, streamlining permit processes, Radio Island development planning and mosquito ditching impacts will also be discussed by CRC committees on Thursday afternoon.

The beach access rules

are proposed to implement the directives of the 1981 General Assembly which created an access program and provided \$1 million to acquire and improve oceanfront property. It is the CRC's general policy that the state's ocean beaches are a resource of statewide significance held in trust for the use and enjoyment of all the citizens.

A permit fee increase from \$10 to \$25 has been proposed to reflect declining federal support and to counter the increasing costs of permit issuance. Staff from the Office of Coastal Management make several visits to project sites, prepare and purchase legal ads to notify the public of the applications and issue the actual permits for the current \$10 fee.

The two task forces of the CRC will examine federal policies for useful ideas for reducing environmental damage from development activities and will discuss principles the Commission should adopt to guide rebuilding efforts after a coastal disaster.

Two permit appeals will be heard during this meeting. A resident of Beaufort will ask the CRC for permission to erect a building on an already-permitted dock. This appeal will be discussed following the Thursday morning public hearings. The second appeal involves a minor development permit issued for a 24 slip marina on Back Creek in Bath. Three parties opposed to the marina will ask the Commission to overturn the permit. This appeal will be heard at 10 A.M. on Friday.

Chowan College Commencement This Sunday

MURFREESBORO — The president and chief executive officer of the American Association of Community and Junior Colleges, Dr. Dale Parnell, will speak at the 2 P.M. commencement service when Chowan College closes its 134th year Sunday.

Rev. J. Felix Arnold, pastor-emeritus of Enfield Baptist Church, who recently completed his fifth term as chairman of the college's Board of Trustees, will speak at the 11 A.M. baccalaureate service. Both services will be held in the Helms Center.

Also participating in the baccalaureate program will be Mrs. Andrea Eason, business professor who will give the invocation; Dr. R. Hargus Taylor, chaplain, who will deliver the scripture and prayer; and James Graham, professor in the Department of Graphic Communications, who will present the benediction.

Social science professor, Charles Paul, will deliver the invocation during the graduation exercises. Chowan President Bruce E. Whitaker will preside and introduce the speakers at

both services.

Parnell, a Monmouth, Ore., native, served as president of Lane Community College in Eugene, Ore. and Oregon Superintendent of Public Instruction. In California, he was chancellor of the San Diego Community College System and president - superintendent of San Joaquin Delta Community College. He assumed his

present position in 1981.

Parnell is an author and lecturer on the subjects of career education, survival education and improving management in schools and colleges.

Rev. Felix Arnold served as pastor of Enfield Baptist Church for over 28 years before his retirement in 1975. He also served as pastor of Boykins (Va.) Baptist Church as director

of youth activities.

A former moderator of the North Roanoke Baptist Association, Mr. Arnold was a U.S. Navy chaplain during World War II.
