## Social Security

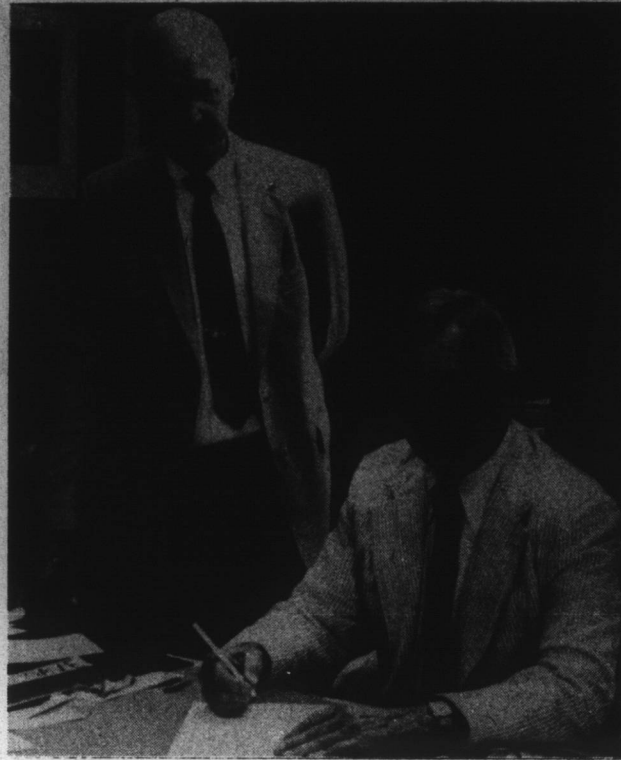
