Winn-Dixie Reports Sales

Winn-Dixie Stores, Inc., reported sales of \$531,837,000 during the four weeks ended April 28, compared with \$489,650,000 for the similar period last year, an increase of 8.6 per cent.

For the 44 weeks ended April 28, the total was \$5,595,647,000 compared with \$5,227,542,000 a year ago, an increase of 7.0 per cent.

The company opened 29 new stores and closed 27 since June 24, 1981, having 1,222 units in operation on April 28, compared with 1,224 last year.
