

Col. Etter To Speak At Graduation

Col. William R. Etter, commanding officer, NARF, Cherry Point, Marine Corps Air Station,

will be the commencement speaker for the fifteenth annual graduation exercise of Craven Community College in New Bern.

Graduation will be June 2, 8 P.M. at New Bern High School Auditorium.

Etter earned a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from the University of Idaho and a master's degree in engineering administration from George Washington University. He was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in June 1956 and since then has moved rapidly upward. Each promotion carried with it greater responsibility.

Today, as commanding officer of the Naval Air Rework Facility, Etter is in charge of one of the largest industrial complexes in the state. He supervises over 3,200 civilian employees and implements a budget in excess of \$200-million.

He is the recipient of the "John Paul Jones Award for Inspirational Leadership,"

and has been profiled in Jane's Who's Who in Aviation and Aerospace.

Col. Etter's personal decorations and awards include: 26 Strike Air Medals, the Joint Services Medal, the Navy Commendation Medal with Combat "V", the Navy Achievement Medal, the Navy Unit Commendation, the National Defense Service Medal with One Bronze Star, the Vietnam Service Medal with Three Bronze Stars, the Republic of Vietnam Cross of Gallantry with Palm, the Republic of Vietnam Meritorious Unit Citation with Palm, and the Vietnam Campaign Medal with Device.

Etter is married to the former Patricia S. Partin, daughter of Jim Partin of Edenton. They have two children: Janet, a senior at ECU, and David, a student at Havelock High School.
