Social Security Report

The Elizabeth City Social Security office is reviewing the status of the 2000 people who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) checks.

The review may be made through the mail in the form of a questionnaire that the recipient will be asked to complete and return to the Social Security office, or by telephone, or through a personal interview.

The purpose of the review is to make certain that recipients are still entitled to receive their monthly payments and that they are being paid in the correct

These reviews are required by law and generally must be done each year and whenever a change that affects occurs eligibility or payment amount.

The questions asked during these contacts are similar to those asked when the recipient first applied for SSI.

The subjects covered will include income, assets, living arrangements, and

Those receiving payments on the basis of disability or blindness may also have to furnish information about their medical condition.

However, recipients should not wait to be contacted before reporting a change in their circumstances.

For example, a change of address or changes in family composition or income may affect monthly payments and must be reported promptly.

Failure to report changes in circumstances may result in an overpayment which the recipient will have to pay back.

A penalty may also be imposed for failure to report a change or for making a false statement.

Additional information about what and how to report may be obtained by calling the Elizabeth City Social Security office at 338-2161.

SSI is a federal needsbased program to provide payments to individuals who are either aged, blind, or disabled and who have limited income and assets.
