

The Little Theatre To Present "A Shot In The Dark"

The Edenton Little Theatre will present the mystery-comedy "A Shot in the Dark" on June 2, 3, 4, and 5 at 8 P.M. in the old

Chowan County Courthouse. The play is produced and directed by Penelope W. Jones. This spicy comedy takes

place in a Magistrate's office and involves the murder of a sullen Spanish chauffeur. The maid, who is the prime suspect, was found naked and unconscious on the floor beside the victim with the murder weapon in her hand. After a hilarious attempt at questioning the girl, the Magistrate, played by Michael Reeve, brings in the victim's employer and his arrogant wife for interrogation.

"A Shot in the Dark" is a series of amusing implications, all of which add up to an exciting climax and a surprise ending that leaves one wondering: does he or doesn't he? The humor is bright and slightly suggestive, and the mystery keeps you trying to guess "whodunit".

Anne Dale plays the part of the simple-minded yet sensuous maid who is forced to reveal her rather adventurous past. Anne and Michael lead off a tremendously good cast, including John Becker, Robert Dail, Penelope Jones, Rhonda Kirby, and Bill Pierce. The talent alone makes this play well worth seeing.
