On Sunday, June 6, there was a pro-ERA march and rally at the State Capitol Building in Raleigh. It's estimated that 8 - 10,000 supporters turned out.

Out of that crowd of 10,000 I saw five supporters from the Tri-county area get the 27th ratified too. (Chowan, Pasquotank and Perquimans).

But at the same time I was embarrassed and mad that none of my neighbors turned out to help reach that goal. When the going got tough they gave up.

I'm truly sorry. They missed out on something very special.

The battle is not over. We will win - and be stronger for the fight. We got the 19th Amendment ratified. We'll ERA won't go away.


