Peat, An Alternate Source Of Energy

RALEIGH - Legislation to promote the use of peat developing new sources of energy was enacted into law Friday by the N.C. General Assembly.

Sponsored by Rep. Howard B. Chapin of Beaufort County, the measure grants a tax credit

to companies or individuals who build facilities in Eastern North Carolina using peat to produce methanol, an alternate source of energy.

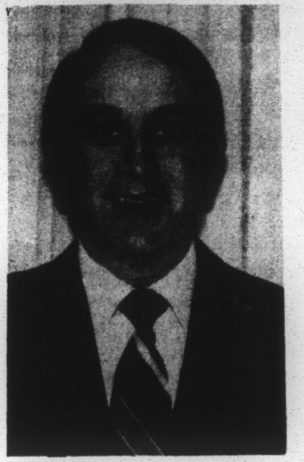
A credit of 20 per cent on corporate and individual income taxes will be granted, effective January

1,1982, to corporations or individuals constructing such facilities. At least one firm, Peat Methanol Associates, is considering building a facility in North-eastern North Carolina.

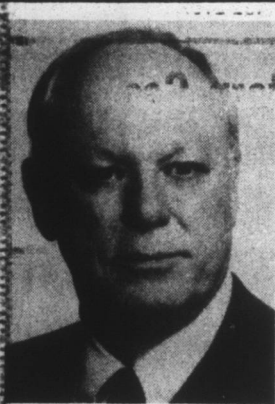

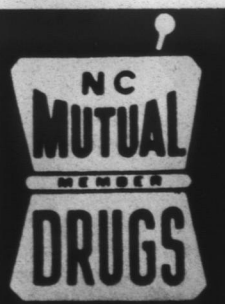
