Scholarship To Be Awarded

The first Wachovia Technical Scholarship will be awarded to a second rear technical student at College of The Albemarle this fall. Lloyd Armstrong, student financial aid director, said applications for the \$500 grant will be accepted through July 15.

Wachovia Bank and Trust Company established a \$250,000 endowment last December, the first such gift in the history of the community college system. Income from the trust will provide 50 technical scholarships, valued at \$500 each, for 37 institutions in the bank's service area. The 13 remaining scholarships will be distributed according to enrollment in technical training programs at the participating institutions.

J. Stanley Peel, Wachovia vice president and city trustees chairman, and one executive in Elizabeth City, said one of the primary considerations of his firm is its concern about the problem of unemployment and underemployment in officio member of the North Carolina.


