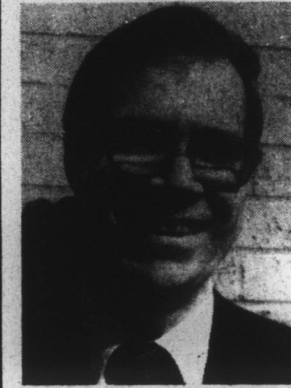
"The Fantasticks" is the longest running show in the history of New York's professional theatre. This romantic and tender tale continues to be appealing
