### Cancer Survey Begun

The American Cancer Society is about to undertake an enormous new Cancer Prevention Study II. Mrs. A.F. Downum, Jr., area director for the ACS, has expressed deep appreciation to Chowan County's Extension Homemakers Association, which will be conducting the survey study in Edenton and Chowan County. Mrs. Yates Parrish, President of the Chowan County Homemakers Council, will coordinate the local volunteer effort during the month of September.

The Cancer Prevention Study II, the largest epidemiological inquiry of its kind ever undertaken, will investigate the health and lifestyles of one and a half million Americans in an attempt to explain the possible high risk of cancer among different racial,

religion, geographic and genetic groups. Food items consumed, exposure to low-level radiation, air and water pollution, drugs, occupational exposures and the possible interaction between various cancer causing substances are among the wide variety of factors which will be included in the survey's questionnaire.

The questionnaire survey, which will involve approximately seventy households locally, will be conducted during the first two weeks in September. Chowan County Extension Homemaker volunteer researchers have received training in special workshops to help instruct their subjects on how to fill out the questionnaires, but they will not see the answers.
