

Volunteer researchers Daisy Bembry, Helen Hollowell, Margaruite Jones, Louise Pratt, Ella Foxwell, Elsie Hare, Elva Stroud, Eula Jordan, Fran Ward and Mary Julia Parrish are among the Extension Homemakers members who will be working closely with the survey.

The American Cancer Society will conduct a six year follow - up program on all "subject" families completing this fall's survey. The first follow - up will come in 1984, with additional follow - ups in 1986 and 1988.


