Heifer Show

Twenty five heifers from throughout Eastern North Carolina were judged by Dr. Pete Patterson at the 2nd Annual Northeastern Heifer Show held on Saturday at the Livestock Arena in Elizabeth City. The heifers were grouped in 5 classes based on their age. Individual classes and winners were: Class I (01-01-81 to 02-28-81) C.F. Stallings, Perquimans County; Class II (03-01-81 to 04-30-81) Lori Lichtenwalner, Chowan County; Class III (09-01-81 to 10-31-81) Kevin Brickhouse, Pasquotank County; Class IV (11-01-81 to 12-31-81) Kevin Brickhouse, Pasquotank County and Class V (01-01-82 to 02-28-82) Harold Smith, Jones County.

Grand Champion heifer came from Class III and was a Simmental cross-bred heifer. The Reserve Grand Champion was the November-December class winner and was also a Simmental heifer.

The Showmanship Competition was divided into a Junior Division for youths 13 and under, and a Senior Division for youths 14 to 21. Leslie Burroughs of Wake County won the Junior Division Showmanship Competition with Chuck Jackson of Pasquotank County winning the Reserve Champion Showmanship trophy.

In the toughest Senior Division, the Stallings family won both trophies with C.F. Stallings winning the Grand Champion Showmanship and his sister Cheryl, the Reserve Champion Showmanship.
